

# CHICAGO TEACHERS' PENSION FUND 2010 TRUSTEE ELECTIONS

## ELECTION NOTICE

The Chicago Teachers' Pension Fund has set the dates for the 2010 Trustee Elections.

### TEACHER TRUSTEE ELECTION

The Teacher Trustee Election will be conducted in schools and at other designated polling places on **Friday, October 29, 2010**. Teachers and other active contributors will elect two trustees to serve three-year terms from November 2010 to November 2013.

### PRINCIPAL/ADMINISTRATOR ELECTION

The Principal/Administrator Election will be conducted by mail ballot. The official date for the election is **Friday, November 5, 2010**. Principal/Administrators will elect one trustee to serve a three-year term from November 2010 to November 2013.

### ELIGIBILITY

*Teachers:* individuals interested in running for a position must hold an Illinois State Teaching Certificate, be current contributors to the CTPF system, and have been assigned on a regular certificate in the Chicago Public or Charter Schools for a minimum of 10 years.

*Principal/Administrators:* individuals interested in running for the position must hold and be employed under a State of Illinois Type 75 Administrative Certificate.

### NOMINATION PACKETS AVAILABLE

Individuals interested in running for office should request a nomination packet from CTPF's election coordinator at 312.604.1400, ext. 234. Eligibility will be verified before the packet is issued. Petitions must be returned to CTPF no later than 5:00 p.m., Friday, October 1, 2010.
