Beneficiary Verification for the Payment of Death Benefits

A person applying for a death benefit must provide:

1. Proof of Identity
 - a. Non-Minor (person over the age of 18):
 - i. Current driver's license, state identification, military identification, or passport.
 - b. Minor (person under the age of 18)
 - i. Birth certificate or a current passport, driver's license, or state identification.
2. Minor's Proof of Age:
 - a. Birth Certificate or current passport.
3. Proof of Name Change (if applicable) - If a beneficiary's name on the documentation of proof of identity differs from the name on the Designation of Beneficiary or in the Fund's records, then the beneficiary must provide:
 - a. Court approved name change order, marriage license/civil union certificate, judgment for dissolution of marriage, or naturalization documentation showing name change.
 - b. A birth certificate may be required in some circumstances if the above documents are not sufficient to demonstrate the name change.

A Religious Organization or Non-Profit Organization applying for a death benefit must provide:

1. Proof of Authorization to Receive Funds on Behalf of the Organization:
 - a. Bylaws or Board Resolution sufficient to show the person applying for the benefit on behalf of the organization is authorized to receive funds on behalf of the organization.

Applicant shall provide a certified translation of any documents originating from a foreign country that is not provided in English.

The Fund, in its discretion, may require additional documentation.
