Pensioner Trustee Election

CTPF will hold elections from **October 20-November 7, 2017**, for three Pensioner representatives to serve on the CTPF Board of Trustees. Pensioners will have the option of voting online or with paper ballots in the election. All paper ballots must be received (*not postmarked*) by November 7, 2017, at 5:00 p.m., to be included in the final tabulation. Pensioners who vote online may cast ballots between 7:00 a.m. on October 20 and 5:00 p.m. on November 7, 2017. Ballots & Candidate Information Mailed

On October 20, 2017, ballots are sent via first-class mail to eligible voters.

Make Your Choice

Pensioners may vote for three Pensioner Trustee candidates either online OR by returning a postage-paid ballot. If you attempt to vote twice (*e.g., both on-line and by paper ballot*), your second ballot will be discarded.

Online Polling Open

Online polling is open from 7:00 a.m. on October 20, 2017, through 5:00 p.m. on November 7, 2017. All votes must be received by 5:00 p.m. on November 7, 2017.

Vote Online

To vote online use your computer, tablet, or mobile device. You will need the Voting PIN printed on the ballot you will receive in the mail in order to vote online.
